

The six (6) giga projects in Riyadh:

Diriyah Gate Project

square-kilometre Diriyah The seven development in the west of Riyadh is centered on the At-Turaif UNESCO World Heritage Site - a mud-brick city that was the original home of the Al Saud family and is known as the "birthplace of the kingdom".

Led by hotel veteran Jerry Inzerillo, the \$63.2 billion development project funded by the Public Investment Fund aims to turn the site into a culture-led tourism destination. When complete, the district will contain 38 hotels, six museums and 26 other cultural attractions. The first phase of the redevelopment – the Terrace premium dining district, which contains 21 restaurants overlooking the mud city – opened at the end of last year.





King Salman Park Project



Currently under construction in central Riyadh, the King Salman Park project aims to be "the largest urban park in the world".

Master-planned Danish by studio Henning Larsen and Saudi Omrania, the 16.7 studio square kilometers park will feature 11 square

square kilometers of green space and one million trees. According to the developer, it will be watered with 100 percent recycled city water.

At the center of the park will be a collection of landmark buildings including the Royal Arts Complex, which will contain a 110 meter high pyramid designed by Ricardo Bofill and a visitor pavilion by Adjaye Associates.

Qiddiya Project

Another project aimed at increasing the country's tourism offering, Qiddiya is described as "Saudi Arabia's emerging capital for entertainment, sports and culture".

Currently under construction to the west of Riyadh, the 367-square-kilometre project will contain numerous entertainment facilities, including sports arenas, concert halls, a racetrack, a Jack Nicklaus-branded golf course and Six Flags (pictured), which will contain the world's longest, tallest and fastest rollercoaster.

The project is 100 per cent owned by the Public Investment Fund.



Murraba Project

Designed to "define Riyadh's new skyline", the Murabba will be a commercial and entertainment district built around a 400-metrehigh cube-shaped skyscraper named Mukaab.

The cube, which will contain two million square meters of shops, and cultural and tourist attractions, will form the center of a 19-square-kilometre development that is designed as a new downtown area for the Saudi capital city.



Led by Saudi crown prince Mohamed Bin Salman, the wider project will contain 100,000 residential units, 9,000 hotel rooms, 980,000 square meters of shops and 1.4 million square meters of office space.

King Abdullah Financial District (KAFD)



The King Abdullah Financial District is a giant office and residential district in Riyadh that is largely complete.

Masterplanned by Danish studio Henning Larsen, the 1,600,000-square-metre development will contain 61 towers and skyscrapers by studios including Saudi practice Omrania, US studios SOM, Gensler and HOK

and UK studios CallisonRTKL and Foster + Partners.

All of the buildings in the development will be connected by a series of air-conditioned bridges, while a six-station monorail system runs around the edge of the site.

The downtown district will be connected to the under-construction Riyadh Metro by the large, Zaha Hadid Architects-designed King Abdullah Financial District (KAFD) Metro Station.

Mohammed Bin Salman Non-profit City



Named after Mohammed bin Salman and funded by his personal foundation, the Mohammed bin Salman Non-profit City, which is also known by the acronym MISK, is being built in Riyadh as a business incubator and a place to support the country's future leaders.

Designed as a 15-minute city with automated buses, the project will be arranged around a central spine covered by a giant shaded system designed by London-based studio CallisonRTKL.

It will also contain a transparent art institute designed by Bahrain-based practice Studio Anne Holtrop, a triangular headquarters for the MISK foundation designed by Australian architecture studio Conrad Gargett and the globe-shaped Center for Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics.

Saudi Entertainment Ventures (SEVEN)

Entirely owned by the Public Investment Fund, Seven has the tagline "making tomorrow entertaining". more organization will develop and entertainment operate 10 districts across the country, with projects in Riyadh (pictured), Almadinah, Tabuk and Yanbu already announced.



Aimed at providing entertainment to the youthful population, the developments will each include indoor arenas, arcades, bowling, indoor golf, climbing, indoor surfing and skydiving centers and cinemas.

	This well-preserved 19th-century clay and mudbrick fortress played a vital role in the recapturing of the city of Riyadh in 1902 –led by Ibn Saud– cementing its role in the unification of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
	The fortress is now a museum that allows visitors to look back to that key moment in history and beyond the history of Riyadh as the capital of the Kingdom

FACTS	The Edge of the World is a place in Riyadh that's known for its dramatic cliffs and panoramic views. From Riyadh, get to the cliffs on the edge of the world and see the natural wonders of Arabia along the way, like Elephant Rock and Jabal Abyad. You'll stand on top of 1000ft (300m) cliffs at Jabal Fihrayn and see the land stretch seemingly forever in front of you. Observe dried rivers, camels wandering around, and hear stories of the ancient caravan route.

National Museum

FACTS	From the Earth to the moon, and from the prehistoric ages to the modern ages, the hallways of the Saudi National Museum will take you on an adventure that transcends time and space. You will witness artistic and historical evidence in the heart of Riyadh in Al Murabba neighborhood near King Abdulaziz palace. The museum was opened in 1419H and spans across a distance of 17,000Km2 where it tells the story of 3,700 artifacts such as statues, scripts and unique sculptures.

King Abdulaziz Historical Center

FACTS	Located in the capital city of Saudi Arabia, Riyadh, the King Abdul Aziz historical center was built on the former compound of the Murabba Palace and is around 1.5 km to the north of the old city. It is famous for its magnificent architecture and eight "Exhibition Halls" each of which is themed around a different part of the region's history, such as Saudi heritage, Islamic culture in Arabia, Arabian kingdoms, The Prophet's Mission, and Islam in the Arabian Peninsula.
	The Center houses an old courtyard house, a mosque, a library, a conference building, and several parks with long, green fields and water showers. Towards the south lies a small theme park that attracts locals and tourists alike. There is also a group of traditional homes in the center that were originally planned as a part of the museum but are now used as reception centers that host major events and ceremonies.








Al Ula

FACTS	Al-Ula is an ancient Arabic oasis city located in Medina Province. Situated in the Hejaz, a region that features prominently in the history of Islam as well as several pre-Islamic Semitic civilizations, al-'Ulā was a market city on the historic incense route that linked India and the Persian Gulf to the Levant and Europe.
	The immediate vicinity contains a unique concentration of precious artifacts, including well-preserved ancient stone inscriptions that illustrate the development of the Arabic language, and a concentration of rock dwellings and tombs that date from the Nabatean and Dedanite periods that coincided with Greco-Roman influence during classical antiquity. Saudi Arabia's first UNESCO World Heritage Site, Hegra (also known as Al-Hijr, or Mada'in Salih), is located 22 km (14 mi) north of the city, in Al-Ula governorate. Built more than 2,000 years ago by the Nabataeans, Hegra is often compared with its sister city of Petra, in Jordan. Meanwhile, the ancient walled city of Al-Ula ("Old Town"), situated near the oasis that allowed for its settlement, contains a dense cluster of mud-brick and stone houses. Al-Ula was also the capital of the ancient Lihyanites (Dedanites).

Saudi Arabia has opened its doors to the world through the tourist visa. You are welcome to discover the warm hospitality of Saudi people, the rich heritage, vibrant culture, and diverse and breathtaking landscapes. The tourist visa can be issued as an eVisa, visa on arrival or through the embassy, and you can enter Saudi through land, sea and air ports. The visit visa grants you the flexibility to pursue any or all the following purposes during your visit:

- Tourism
- Family and Friends
- Medical
- Umrah
- Business

Visit Visa can be obtained by either of the following:

- Visa on Arrival
- eVisa
- Through Saudi Consulate (Consulate Visa)

Visa on Arrival



Tourist can apply for Visa on Arrival at one of Saudi Arabia's entry points if any of the following conditions apply:

- The tourist is from one of the countries in the *63 Eligible Countries list.
- The tourist is holding USA, United Kingdom, or Schengen visas. The following requirements must apply:
 - The visa is valid.
 - The visa type is either tourist or business.
 - The visa has to be used at least once and have an entry stamp of the issuing country.
- Holders of permanent residence from (US,UK or EU) after ensuring presence of the resident. This includes first-degree relatives of the visa holders coming with them.

*Among the 63 eligible countries are: USA, Canada, UK, Brunei, China (including Hongkong), Japan, Malaysia, Singapore, South Korea, Thailand, Australia, and New Zealand.

























eVisa



Saudi Arabia is opening its doors to the world through its new tourist visa. Through the fast and easy-to-use online portal, international visitors from 63 eligible countries can apply for an eVisa and discover the warm hospitality of Saudi people the rich heritage, vibrant culture, and diverse and breathtaking landscapes; from the mountains of Abha to the beaches of the Red Sea to the shifting sands of the Empty Quarter.

The eVisa will be a one-year, multiple entry visa, allowing tourists to spend up to 90 days in the country. The tourist visa allows you to take part in tourism-related activities such as, events, family & relatives visits, leisure, and Umrah (excluding Hajj) and excludes other activities such as studying.

Tourists from Eligible Countries can apply for a tourist visa online through the e-Visa portal ahead of their trip.

Consulate Visa



Tourists that are not from eligible countries list should apply for a consulate visa through <u>Saudi Embassies And Consulates</u>.

What type of Visa you need to Visit Saudi?

To find out what type of Visa you need to visit Saudi Arabia, please go to https://www.visitsaudi.com/en/travel-regulations and fill out the necessary fields. You will be directed to choose the following:

- Your nationality
- To select whether you are a:
 - (1) US, UK, or Schengen resident or business or tourist visa holder, or
 - (2) a GCC resident, or
 - (3) not any of the above.
- Depending on your choice above that is applicable to you, you will be required to choose which Options you will prefer to apply for a Visa (e.g. if you selected either 1 or 2, you will be directed to choose either eVisa or Transit/Stopover Visa. If you selected 3, Options on Embassy/Consulate or Authorized visa Offices will appear.

You can use the tourist visa to perform Umrah but not during the Haji may apply for Umrah or Ziyarah permits via Nusuk season. Visitors platform. To perform Hajj, tourists must apply for a specific Hajj visa through the Ministry of Hajj and Umrah.

Do I need the medical insurance to apply for tourist visa?

A health insurance policy, which covers COVID-19 medical treatment, is issued along with your eVisa and its cost is included within the eVisa fee. Medical insurance coverage is valid for one year from the date of issue. It matches the validity of the tourist visa (one year from the date of issue).

You can enquire about your health insurance policy and health care service providers from the Council of Health Insurance.

How much does a tourist eVisa cost?

The tourist visa cost varies. You check the cost on the Visa Requirement page for more information on the application process and costs.

Can tourist visa holders visit Makkah and Al Madinah?

The holy city of Makkah is reserved for Muslim visitors only, while Al Madinah is open to all tourists. There are also many sites around Makkah that offer a fascinating glimpse into local culture and history.

My country is not included in the tourist eVisa program. Can I still apply for a tourist visa?

Everyone is welcome to apply for the tourist visa which can be issued as an eVisa, visa on arrival or through the embassy. You can check available methods to apply for a trourist visa on the Visa Requirement page.

Can I cancel my eVisa or get a refund if my eVisa is rejected?

No, the tourist visa fees are non-refundable in any case as described in Clause 5.3 of the Terms and Conditions...

























Entry Requirements

Can I get a visa on arrival when traveling to Saudi?

The tourist visa can be issued as an eVisa, visa on arrival or through the embassy. You can check your eligibility for the visa on arrival through the Visa Requirement page.

How can I apply for the Transit visa?

Visitors can obtain the transit visa ahead of time through the embassy or electronically while booking flights through SAUDIA or Flynas.

I hold a Schengen / UK / US visa. Can I get a tourist visa on arrival in Saudi Arabia?

Yes, USA, UK, and Schengen tourist or business visa holders are eligible for Saudi tourist visa on arrival. Please check the Visa requirement page for more information.

My flight has a stops-over in Saudi Arabia, do I need to apply for a transit visa?

If you are planning to enter Saudi Arabia on your way to your final destination, you need to apply for a transit visa. The transit visa can be obtained ahead of time through the embassy or electronically while booking your flights on SAUDIA or Flynas.

I have a permanent residency permit from the UK, US, or the EU. Can I apply for a visa on arrival?

Yes, U.K, U.S. and EU permanent residents are eligible for Saudi tourist visa on arrival. Please check the Visa requirement page for more information.

I'm not planning on visiting Saudi Arabia but my flight stops in the country, do I still need a transit visa?

A transit visa will be required if the traveler plans to exit the transit area and pass through immigration.

If you have two separate bookings while transiting through Saudi Arabia which requires you to pass through immigration, you must obtain a transit visa to enter the country and check-in again for your next flight.

However, If you have one booking transiting through Saudi Arabia which does not require you to pass through immigration, you do not need to obtain a transit visa as you don't need to check-in for the next flight.

Can I enter Saudi Arabia as a tourist?

You will obtain the medical insurance as a part of the tourist visa application process.

I am a GCC resident, am I eligible for the tourist visa?

Yes, GCC residents are welcome to apply for the tourist visa which can be issued as an eVisa, visa on arrival or through the embassy. You can check your eligibility for an eVisa through the Visa Requirements page.

What is the duration of stay for the tourist visa?

The tourist visa is a multiple entry visa which is valid for one year, and permits 90 days period of stay. Please check the Visa requirement page for more information.

I have a GCC residency, can my family apply for the tourist visa?

Yes, you can apply for first-degree family members (husband, wife, parents, and children) using your account after you submit your application.

- Your visa must be a business or tourist visa.
- Your visa must have been used at least once and have an entry stamp from the issuing country (Digital entry stamp are not accepted).
- Your passport must be valid for a minimum of six months beyond the date of entry into Saudi.

Residents from the U.K, U.S. and EU can apply for eVisa if the below conditions are met:

- You must hold a permanent residence permit from a country located in the U.K., U.S. or EU.
- Your passport must be valid for a minimum of six months beyond the date of entry into Saudi.

Visa on Arrival

Once you arrive at your destination's airport or entry point in Saudi, use the self-service devices (KIOSK) or go directly to the passport control office to apply for your visa on arrival.

- Visa on Arrival Price: SAR 300 (about USD 80).
- Medical Insurance Fees: SAR 95 (about USD 25.33).
- Entry: Multiple Entry or single entry depending on Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- Validity: The multiple entry visa is valid for a year from its issue date. The visa allows for stays of up to 90 days.

Requirements

U.S., U.K. or Schengen Visa Holders can qualify for visa on arrival if the below conditions are met:

- Your visa must be a business or tourist visa.
- Your visa must have been used at least once and have an entry stamp from the issuing country (Digital entry stamp are not accepted).
- Your passport must be valid for a minimum of six months beyond the date of entry into Saudi.

Residents from the U.K, U.S. and EU can apply for a visa on arrival if the below conditions are met:

- You must hold a permanent residence permit from a country located in the U.K., U.S. or EU.
- Your passport must be valid for a minimum of six months beyond the date of entry into Saudi.

Any type of visa will allow travelers to perform Umrah. Don't forget to book your Umrah appointment through Nusuk platform.
